Many of the leases are more than 60 years old and include minimum royalty and other tricky obligations.

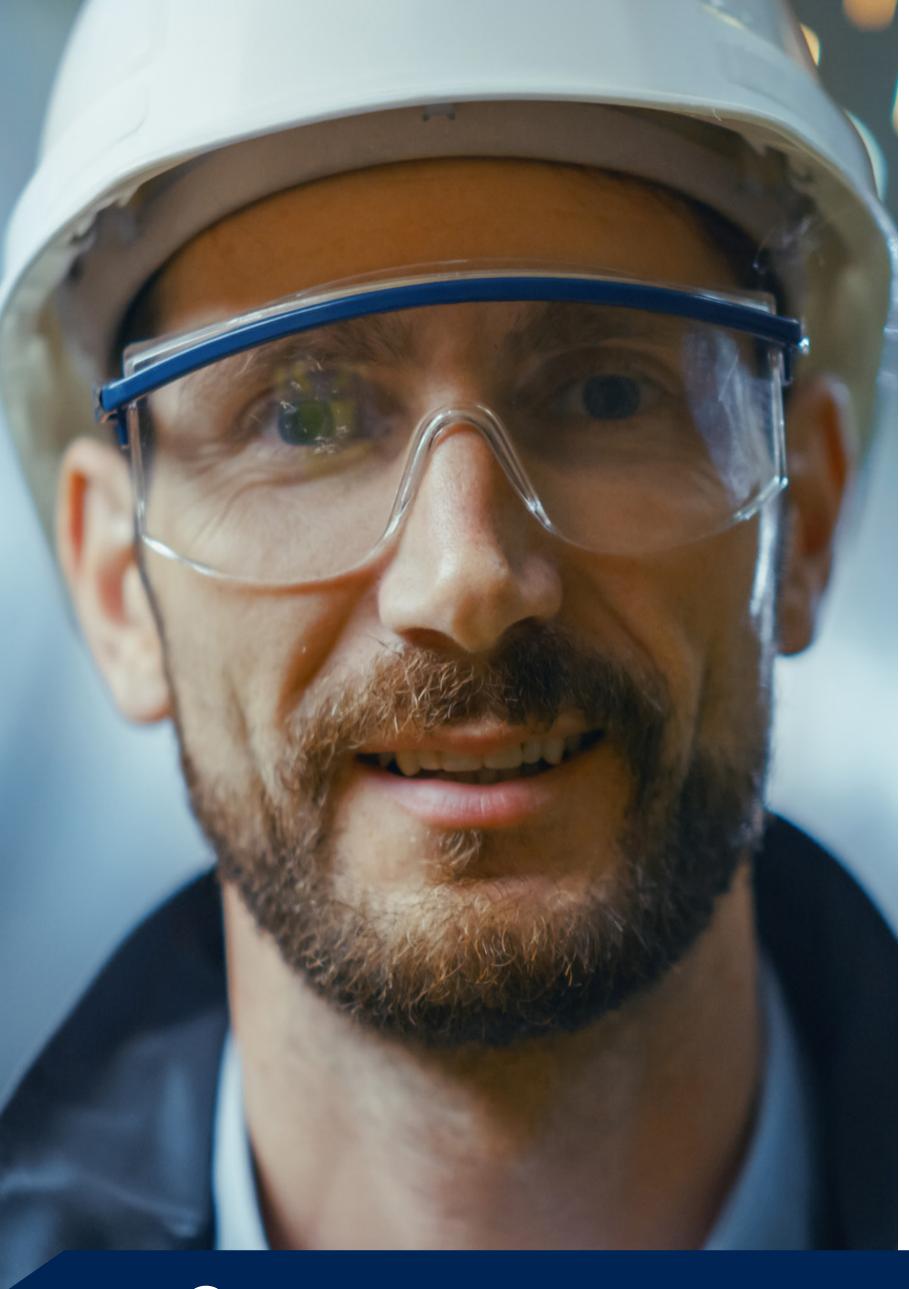
Having very little initial understanding of the outstanding lease obligations contained within these old leases with multiple operators and severed horizons was a huge concern for Pantera.

Because most of the oil & gas leases had never been imaged, Pantera would have to rely exclusively on the data housed in the seller's land system to ensure all lease and surface obligations. Those records were delivered to Pantera in more than 25 different CSV files that were difficult for any outsider to decipher. It was overwhelming Pantera needed much more than a land system.
