Course Brand Guide Purpose

This branding guide details the features within a NovoEd course that you can customize to your branding style.

This guide does not cover institution-level branding, so please talk to your Customer Success Manager about those options.

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Overview

Course Branding Benefits

Custom branding is a valuable opportunity to not only give the course a consistent look and feel, but also accelerate outcomes beneficial to your organization.

People engage with information deeply and are empowered to apply new knowledge to behavior when learning feels personalized, connected, and purposeful. In addition to reinforcing a collective goal and encouraging a social-collaborative mindset, infusing your brand into course material nurtures the culture of learning that will keep your team highperforming and nimble.

We encourage you to take advantage of as many opportunities as you can to implement custom branding in your course—your learners will benefit from an optimized learning environment and your organization will reap the benefits!

Opportunities & Limitations

The NovoEd platform is designed to enable many customizable opportunities for course builders to drive branding and company culture. With relatively few limitations, The NovoEd engine connects learning to purpose holistically, comprehensively, and intuitively.

Below are the 3 categories of customizations that will be explored in this guide.



COURSE CUSTOMIZATIONS

Course customizations are primarily structural. They establish an overarching course visual identity while unifying institutional branding and core learning goals.



LESSON CUSTOMIZATIONS

Customizations within lesson pages are more granular in nature, offering opportunities within components to infuse company branding and reinforce community as learners engage deeply with content.

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ADDITIONAL CUSTOMIZATIONS

This section covers the customizations that are not course OR lesson specific (general or apply to both), plus opportunities that are not enabled natively by platform functions, but can be incorporated with ease.

Customization Limitations

×	Our platform uses one default font Open Sans (in certain fields/ components, there is the option to select from 6 preset text sizes).
×	Main Call to Action (CTA) buttons (the mark as done, enter course, resume learning, and submit buttons) will all be blue.
×	The activity header and the icons above activity components will be NovoEd blue (Read, Submit, Take, Watch). The use of NovoEd blue across standard elements is intentional.
×	The Novoed favicon in the bottom left corner cannot be removed.
×	The layout of the Learner Dashboard is not customizable.
×	The tabs that appear on the course homepage are default (Course Outline, To-Dos, Points).
×	Linked text will be NovoEd blue.
×	Page backgrounds are white and the margins are standardized - neither can be customized.
×	The maximum width of the text block is always 800px.
×	There are limited color options in the text with image templates and the simple text editor.

The asset sizes suggested in this guide give you the best starting point to optimize each component to display your image in the way you intend. Where relevant, we've also included notes about how an image will crop or resize under different conditions.

FILE SIZE RECOMMENDATIONS

Some of our components have file size limits and others do not. The components with size limits are defined throughout this guide. Even for components without size limits, **consider keeping your file sizes small to optimize image load times for users with lower bandwidth**.

SUPPORTED MEDIA FILE TYPES

- Unless otherwise specified on component pages, you may use any listed file type listed under each media type.
- With that said, there are advantages to using certain file types, particularly for image components (most common media type).

IMAGE FILE FORMAT RECOMMENDATIONS

.JPG Ideal format for photographs, does not support transparent background

.PNG Supports transparent background.Ideal for logos, but larger file size than .jpg

.GIF Supports animation and transparent background, but larger file size than .png

.SVG Supports transparent background and sharper than .png, ideal format for images that include text

RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

UNDERSTANDING RESPONSIVENESS & CROPPING BEHAVIOR

WHAT IS RESPONSIVENESS?

NovoEd pages are responsive, which means that they'll automatically be optimized for each individual user's screen resolution and window size to provide the best viewing experiences for our users, as shown in the example below.



We never stretch images to make them fit a component. Instead, if you upload an image that is a different size ratio than the image space of a component, it will be automatically cropped to the center (if it's too big) or displayed with white space (if it's too small).

Best Practices & Considerations



TITLE CONSISTENCY

Decide on a standard format for titles and use it consistently throughout the course. Consider whether you want to use title case vs. sentence case. Decide whether your titles will list topics, describe activity types, or follow another specific format. For example:

"Read: Course Branding Guidelines" vs. "Course Branding Guidelines"

TIME ESTIMATE ON EACH PAGE

You can list a time estimate for each page, or choose to leave it out. Either way, decide on a standard and use it consistently.

INCLUDING TRANSCRIPTS

For accessibility, consider including downloadable transcripts with each of your videos.

NAMING COMPONENTS

By default, activity components show their generic name, such as "Survey," "Quiz," etc. Click the generic title on the lesson page to customize it to something unique to that activity. Like your titles, pick a standard naming convention for activity components and stick to it. This organization will help you later when you're studying course data!

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION



Banner image OR color that contains your course title and optional overlayed course logo.



The homepage header appears on the top of your course outline.

Course Title & Logo

You can set your course title in black or white text, and upload a course-level logo image (3 size options).



RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

BANNER IMAGE

For pages in a web browser, we recommend a banner with a 5:1 ratio. To best accommodate all screen sizes and mobile views, we recommend using a banner image sized **2000 x 1350px.**

Note: Our header images are responsive and will be center-cropped to only show a portion of the full image.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS



- Abstract images tend to be safe choices with variable cropping considered, but we always recommend using a decorative or abstract image without text.
- There will be a light gradient black mask put on top of the image to ensure the readability of the course title. Your uploaded image will appear a little bit darker than the original image.

We recommend resizing your browser to different screen sizes to test how the image responds.

To best accommodate all screen sizes and mobile views, we recommend using a banner image sized **2000 x 350px.**

Course Cover Image

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION



Image that represents the course, used by learners to navigate smoothly from one course to another, without disrupting the learning experience by returning to their dashboard.

This image appears in two different spots with two different dimensions:

RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

NOTE:

The left-hand navigation menu is where learners will see this asset most often.

Tip: To accommodate both assets, use a **wide 3:1 aspect ratio with a minimum height of 300px** that has the important part of the image centered.

Course Email Header

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

Header image incorporated in all of your emails from NovoEd to learners and admins of a course.

The email header template appears as the top portion of an embedded email for the course.

Design Options

The most common practice is using a company logo image (with a transparent background) placed on top of a color bar customized with HTML. However, some people prefer to use an image as the header.

RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

We recommend 50px tall, but height can be customized using HTML.

Note: The scaling of the image depends on the recipient's email platform. The desktop version of MS Outlook does not render image size.

FILE SPECIFICATIONS

File format: .png, .gif (transparent background)

Note: We will add the background color with HTML according to the HEX code you supply. We also recommend that there is very little padding around the image in the original file.

File size: No maximum file size

Think about the actions you want them to take, e.g. fill out their profile, view the course information, watch the videos they have watched, follow the discussions, etc.

Lesson Customizations

Lesson Page Header

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

Banner image, GIF, OR color that contains the lesson title. The default, built-in lesson header also contains an optional field to input a time estimate to complete the material.

The lesson page header appears at the top of each lesson page in your course.

Same Specifications as Course Homepage Header Please refer to **Page 12** for comprehensive examples (disregard references to course logo).

You can hide the lesson header completely and either not have one or upload an image directly to the lesson page (full-screen width) or use a text with image background.

Some people like to do this because it gives them more branding options. The course menu/outline will still pull the title text and time estimate from the hidden header, but the time estimate will no longer show at the top of your lesson page.

RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

For pages in a web browser, we recommend a banner with a **5:1 ratio**. To best accommodate all screen sizes and mobile views, we recommend using a banner image sized **2000 x 1350px**.

Note: Our header images are responsive and will be center-cropped to only show a portion of the full image. The edges will be cropped when the left hand navigation menu is open.

FILE SPECIFICATIONS

File format: .png, .jpg, .gif, or .svg File size: Below 1 MB recommended for faster load times

Note: You can use animated gifs in headers as well (but note that large files may load slowly)

Lesson Card View Images

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

Card view is an alternative to the default course outline view that includes a "card" image to represent each lesson. Learners often prefer this visual outline format, though it is less condensed than the standard outline view.

Card view images appear on the course homepage.

Default & Override

By default, the card view image will display the color or image used in the lesson page header. You can override the default card view image in the course outline.

Lesson Accordions

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

Accordions are expandable horizontal menus that give an "interactive" feel with the ability to expand or collapse content.

Accordions can be added throughout lessons to help break up content in a large lesson.

Template Options

Each accordion style allows for further customization/ styling based on the selected template such as text color or background color.

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RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

ACCORDION STYLE 5

Accordion Style 5 enables course builders to either upload an image or select an icon from an icon library.

If an image is used, we recommend uploading a **130 x 130px** graphic.

Note: The image will be cropped to center in a square if dimensions fall outside of this.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

 If the title next to the image in Style 5 is long enough to change to 2 lines (not common), the image dimensions will get taller and no longer be square, as shown below.

We never stretch images, so it will just show more of the image. If the image is smaller than $65 \times 65px$ in this case, it will be centered and displayed with a background color rather than stretched. This is part of why we recommend at least $130 \times 130px$ images.

Lesson Title Styles

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

A title is a header within a lesson page. There are 3 different title styles to choose from.

Titles help structure different topics within a lesson and are followed by relevant lesson content.

Template Options

You can customize the look and feel of each style. **For Title Style 3,** you can choose from a library of icons that exists in NovoEd or upload your own images. See <u>Icon Library/Custom Icons</u> for more information.

Lesson Styled Links

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

Styled links can be leveraged to draw the learner's attention to actions and resources and add visual appeal to a URL.

Styled links can be used on any URL.

NovoEd provides two link styles. One of the style enables you to incorporate a small image.

Lesson Page Dividers

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

NovoEd provides a simple line component that will span the width of the lesson page within the standard margins (800px). This can have a custom color and thickness. Alternatively, you may insert a thin image to use as a page divider.

Page Dividers can be used anywhere on a lesson page to break up content and are often used to indicate the end of a page.

RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

NovoEd offers a page divider component that enables customization for the thickness and the color. If you prefer to use an image as a section divider. Use a **2000px wide image** if you want something that can extend to full screen beyond the standard margins of a lesson page.

Lesson Video Thumbnails (Custom)

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

You can easily customize a video thumbnail (preview image) that displays before a video is played with a clearer image, one that represents the video better, and/or a custom designed image.

The custom video thumbnail will appear as a preview image on the video component, and next to the video in video playlists.

Default Behavior

When uploading a video file directly to NovoEd (as opposed to embedding a video using a weblink), a default frame or generic logo will appear as the video thumbnail unless you override it with a custom thumbnail.

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

An icon to represent a newly formed group or team that supports personalized learner communities.

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The Group/Team image appears on the left hand navigation menu once you're in a team, as well as on top of team discussion activities in a page and on the "Team formation" component once you've been added to the team.

Note

Groups and Teams are not always enabled in a course.

RECOMMENDED DIMENSIONS

We recommend using an image sized 200 x 200px.

Note: Any image larger than 200 x 200px will crop to the center in a square

Additional Customizations Icon Library/Custom Icons

DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

NovoEd offers an icon library native to the platform and enables course builders to utilize custom icons. Icon usage depends on use-case.

You can either use the icon library or upload your own icons/images in Accordion Style 5 and Title Style 3. The icon library also appears in the styled link component, but you can't upload custom icons.

Icon Color You can only customize the icon colors directly within NovoEd when using icons from the NovoEd icon library.

Colored Border on Images

Another small place to add your brand colors is by using your brand colors to create borders on images.

RECOMMENDED FORMAT
