

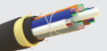
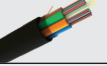


Right-of-Way (ROW) Solutions Guide

This guide is intended to direct end-users to possible cable product solutions based on their aerial and underground rights-of-way. Products are given relative ratings to quickly illustrate which options are suitable and preferred for a given application. Please contact AFL for a more in-depth discussion of the trade-offs for your unique application.

RATING	EXPLANATION
Good	Products rated Good are usable for the application but may not be the most convenient or cost-effective solutions as they were designed primarily for other applications. Such products may be worth considering in cases where standardized inventory is a priority or where product is urgently needed, and the target solution is not available as quickly. These products may also have some technical limitations within the application.
Better	Products rated Better fall in between Good and Best . These products often bear extra capability or materials that are not required for the application but can still be used quite economically within the space.
Best	Products rated Best are the ideal choice as they have been engineered specifically for the application. Such products will generally be the most economical and convenient to install in the target applications.
Not Recommended	Products with this rating are not recommended for the application due to technical limitations and/or a high level of cost-ineffectiveness.
